Bonsai & Saitama



Bonsai is a type of potted plant. A special characteristic of bonsai and its tradition in Japan is the way in which the plants are trimmed and shaped so as to resemble fully grown trees on a small scale, thereby creating natural vistas within the borders of the pot. Many bonsai are over 100 years old.

About 90 years ago, bonsai masters, fleeing Tokyo after the Great Kanto Earthquake, came to Kita-ku in Saitama City where they established new bonsai gardens in the area now called "Omiya Bonsai Village". Today, Omiya Bonsai Village is visited by many bonsai enthusiasts from around the world including aspiring bonsai artists who come to hone their skills.

There are currently 65 bonsai gardens in operation, all free to visit, which also offer bonsai for sale at reasonable prices. Come stroll along the garden paths of Omiya Bonsai Village and enjoy the beauty of bonsai, now officially designated as one of Saitama City's traditional arts and crafts.
